Las Vegas has a variety of must-see attractions and entertainment options to keep visitors occupied. From thrilling roller coasters to zip lines and an observation wheel, Las Vegas' attractions appeal to people around the world.

COMING SOON

Golden Entertainment will bring **Atomic Range**, a 92,000-square-foot golf entertainment destination, to **The STRAT Hotel**, **Casino & SkyPod** in 2023. Created by Flite Golf & Entertainment, Atomic Range will span four stories and feature more than 100 hitting bays across seven acres to offer an immersive, technology-enhanced experience through game play and entertainment. The premier golf entertainment destination will also feature four bars, meeting space, and a 12,000-square-foot Astrocade.

WHAT'S NEW

The ARCADE at Bally's Las Vegas is now open, as the resort continues its transformation to Horseshoe Las Vegas. Spanning 7,000 square feet, the space offers more than 80 supersized games for a high-energy, multi-sensory experience for all ages. Games include classic favorites like Skee-Ball, air hockey and Rock the Rim, as well as immersive virtual reality games like "King Kong" and an interactive four-player game, "Mission Impossible." The ARCADE will also soon feature an enhanced bar with a wide variety of bottled and draft beers, wine and cocktails.

The **Bellagio Conservatory & Botanical Gardens** at **Bellagio Resort & Casino** routinely features fabulous floral and plant displays. The installations change with each season and also include special holiday and Lunar New Year displays.

Running through Sunday, April 16, 2023, **Leonardo da Vinci: The Exhibition** is now open at the **Grand Canal Shoppes** at **The Venetian Resort Las Vegas**. This exhibition immerses you in the mind of history's greatest artist and scientist through original Italian Renaissance paintings by the disciples of Leonardo's workshop, the reconstruction of machines based on original designs made by the artist himself, and the most controversial self-portrait ever found in Italy ("Tavola Lucana")—in the United States for the first time—attributed to da Vinci by Prof. Nicola Barbatelli.

THINGS TO DO

AREA15, located minutes from the Las Vegas Strip, is the world's first experiential art and entertainment complex. The new 40,000-square-foot complex offers immersive activations, monumental art installations, unique retail, ground-breaking technology, bars, eateries and much more. Visitors can experience Birdly, a flight simulator; Brainstorm, an artificial intelligence experience; Dueling Axes, an axe-throwing lounge; Emporium, an arcade and craft cocktail and beer bar; Five Iron Golf an indoor golf experience; Haley's Comet, a zipline; Illuminarium, an

immersive sensory experience; Liftoff, an outdoor ride with panoramic views of the Strip; Lost Spirits Distillery; Meow Wolf's Omega Mart, an immersive art installation; Museum Fiasco, an audiovisual installation; O'KEEFE: One Hundred Flowers, an immersive art exhibit; OZ Ride, a virtual reality adventure; Particle Quest, an augmented reality experience; Virtuals VR, a virtual reality experience; and Wink World: Portals Into The Infinite, a psychedelic art house. The complex also features food and beverage outlets, including The Beast by Todd English, Emack & Bolio's ice cream shop, Liftoff Bar, Lumin Café & Kitchen, Makers & Finders coffee shop, the Oddwood cocktail bar, Rocket Fizz candy store, Sanctuary Lounge.

The Bellagio has several stunning attractions for visitors. The Conservatory and Botanical Gardens display gorgeous plants, flowers, trees and rare botanical finds from all over the world. Admire the essence of every season in this ever-changing attraction. After exploring the Conservatory, head over to the Bellagio Gallery of Fine Art where world-class art is displayed and exhibits change twice a year. Complete your visit with the world-famous Fountains of Bellagio. More than 1,000 water-emitting devices are carefully choreographed to opera, classical, and pop music, as well as other whimsical musical selections, designed to romance your senses. Each performance is unique in expression and interpretation so no matter how many times you have seen the Fountains, they always have more in store.

Travel back in time and into the fascinating world of Roman mythology with the **Fall of Atlantis**, a free fountain show inside **The Forum Shops** at **Caesars Palace**.

Thrill-seekers have their pick of two roller coasters at **The Adventuredome** at **Circus Circus**, the largest indoor theme park in America. The **Canyon Blaster** features back-to-back vertical loops and corkscrews, while the **El Loco** boasts a 90-degree drop!

Dream Racing at the **Las Vegas Motor Speedway** features the world's largest and fastest selection of supercars and allows guests to get behind the wheel of a Lamborghini, Ferrari, Porsche or Lotus race car. No matter which package you choose, it is sure to be a once in a lifetime exotic car racing experience.

Las Vegas' first flight ride attraction, **FlyOver**, takes guests on a multi-sensory journey over 22 of the United States' most stunning destinations in an original flight ride film, "The Real Wild West." Using state-of-the-art technology, the flight is viewed in 8k resolution on a massive 52.5-foot screen with mists, scents and wind to be fully immersive while riders glide over landmarks in Nevada, Oregon, Washington, Montana, California, Arizona, Utah, Colorado, Wyoming and New Mexico during the 25-minute experience. Visitors can also soar over volcanoes and glaciers, as FlyOver also offers the "Experience Iceland" flight ride film.

PanIQ Room, one of the fastest growing escape room franchises in the nation, recently opened its flagship location at **Grand Canal Shoppes** inside **The Venetian Resort Las Vegas**. The location features seven next-generation escape rooms, with never-before-seen puzzles and games, making it among the largest and most diverse gameplay experiences in Vegas. The venue also offers a full-service bar and lounge featuring an array of thematic drinks.

A playground for adults, **Dig This!** is the only place in Las Vegas that allows you to drive an excavator or bulldozer. Tear, dig, rip and claw to your heart's content (under the supervision of the instructors, of course).

Escape Blair Witch, an immersive attraction from Global content leader Lionsgate and leading Las Vegas attraction producer, Egan Escape Productions, is now open. Based on the classic horror film franchise *The Blair Witch*, the escape experience is in the same expansive facility that houses Lionsgate's fan favorite, The Official SAW Escape: Las Vegas, the world's first immersive escape experience themed after the blockbuster *SAW* films, which launched in 2018.

Escape rooms are always a fun and engaging activity! If you're looking to play detective with some mind-bending puzzles, visit **Mind Twist Escape Experience** at **Fashion Show Las Vegas**. The reality entertainment experience features a variety of themed rooms for guests to enjoy – Stag Party, Steampunk Train and Cannibal – each boasting an exciting storyline with a series of puzzles and riddles that are designed to engage all participants, from first timers to escape room pros.

Animal lovers can visit the **Wildlife Habitat** at **Flamingo Las Vegas** to see Chilean flamingos, swans, ducks, Koi, goldfish and turtles.

Downtown's famous casino-lined Fremont Street has been converted into a 175,700-square-foot pedestrian area covered by the Viva Vision canopy, the world's largest graphic display system. Called the **Fremont Street Experience**, this canopy showcases spectacular light and sound shows every hour on the hour during the evenings. If you're looking for thrills of a different nature, ride **SlotZilla**, the world's most unique zip line attraction at Fremont Street Experience promises the time of your life, every time. Both SlotZilla's lower "Zipline" (77 feet) and upper "Zoomline" (114 feet) offer thrills for all.

FLY LINQ is the Las Vegas Strip's first zipline and features 10 side-by-side ziplines, capable of simultaneously launching all riders. Guests take off from a 114-foot-tall tower in the direction of **The High Roller**, flying 1,121 feet along **The LINQ Promenade** at approximately 35 miles per hour.

Golden Nugget Hotel & Casino has the first **GOLD to go ATM** in Las Vegas. The GOLD to go ATM vending machine dispenses 24-karat gold bars of various weights ranging between 1 to 250 grams. The vending machine, located in the Gold Tower Lobby across from the world's largest gold nugget, the Hand of Faith, also sells traditional gold coins and signature gold bars featuring the Golden Nugget logo.

Explore Las Vegas and the surrounding areas like never before with a **helicopter tour**. There are several tour operators in and around the Las Vegas Valley with flights to the Grand Canyon, Hoover Dam, over the Strip and other natural wonders in the desert southwest.

The High Roller is one of the tallest observation wheels in the world at an impressive 550 feet tall and is located at **The LINQ Promenade**. Towering above The LINQ Promenade's \$550 million outdoor, dining, entertainment and retail district by Caesars Entertainment, the High Roller provides spectacular views of the Las Vegas Strip and Valley. The attraction even offers an option for a Happy Half-hour, allowing passengers to enjoy an in-cabin bar serving cocktails on their 30-minute revolution.

The Hunger Games: The Exhibition is now open at MGM Grand Hotel & Casino and features a spectacular, fully immersive archery training experience, as well as new interactives, set decoration and costumes. The thrilling experience features several inspirational galleries including the Hall of Justice, President Snow's Office, the Tribute Train, District 13, and an

archery training experience set within a 60-foot-wide interactive digital training lab, which is a climactic highlight of the exhibition and the first of its kind on the Strip.

Vegas Indoor Skydiving simulates the free-falling sensation of sky diving in a controlled setting with trampoline floor and padded walls. Without the airplane ride, parachute or gut-wrenching leap, guests can earn their wings with an indoor and controllable wind tunnel.

Lake Las Vegas also offers a plethora of activities, both on the water and off. You can hit the green at either of the two luxury golf courses, shop or indulge in the many restaurants. Those looking for fun in the sun can head to the marina to rent a variety of boats, stand up paddleboards, flyboards, canoes, kayaks, gondola rides and more.

Man-made **Lake Mead** is the largest reservoir in the United States and is most famous for **The Hoover Dam**. This peaceful lake is nestled among two beautiful mountain ranges, The River Mountains and the Muddy Mountains, that create a gorgeous backdrop. Approved activities for the Lake Mead National Recreation area include camping, hiking, swimming, boating and horseback riding. This is one of the most popular excursions from Las Vegas, visited by upward of 7 million people annually.

The **Lion Habitat Ranch**, located in Henderson, Nevada, is home to more than 50 exotic animals, including ostriches, emus, lions and a giraffe. Visitors can view these animals in their natural habitats.

Come face-to-face with some of the earth's most fascinating creatures in North America's only predator-based aquarium and exhibit at **Shark Reef Aquarium** at **Mandalay Bay Resort & Casino**. Visitors journey through a tunnel with views of a replica ancient temple ruin and a sunken ship surrounded by several varieties of sharks and other predatory creatures.

The Volcano at **The Mirage Hotel & Casino** features a primal volcanic environment of sound, light, music and heat with choreographed fire shooters that send massive fireballs more than 12 feet into the air.

The National Museum of Organized Crime and Law Enforcement, better known as **The Mob Museum**, is a world-class destination in downtown Las Vegas dedicated to telling the thrilling story of the downfall of organized crime led by law enforcement. True stories of the mob's history are brought to life in a bold and contemporary style via engaging exhibits, high-tech theater presentations and more than 600 artifacts – the largest collection of the mob's and related law enforcement memorabilia under one roof. In February of 2018, The Mob Museum unveiled a major renovation of the first floor which now includes a brand-new exhibition space called Organized Crime Today, focusing on the modernization and evolution of organized crime in the present day. In addition, two new experiential spaces include the Use of Force Training Experience and Crime Lab, which join the Museum's already robust experiential platform, focusing on methods employed by law enforcement to apprehend and prosecute criminals and their organizations. Mobsters and flappers unite! The Mob Museum also unveiled their newest addition: The Underground. This expansive Prohibition history exhibition occupies the entire basement level of the Museum and includes a working distillery and speakeasy.

Guests can venture back through the decades to the 1950s at **The Atomic Museum**, an affiliate of the Smithsonian Institution. The museum is one of the most comprehensive collections of nuclear history and details the history of nuclear testing that occurred in the desert north of Las

Vegas while offering insight in atmospheric testing, radiation, development, underground testing and atomic culture.

For a little tamer but equally thrilling experience, **The Big Apple Coaster** at **New York-New York Hotel & Casino** is a roller coaster that plunges, twists and loops around the resort. The Big Apple was the world's first coaster to feature a 180-degree "heartline" twist and dive maneuver, providing millions of riders with heart-stopping action and excitement. Rising 203 feet, the "heartline" provides a sensation like that felt by a pilot during a barrel roll in an airplane.

The Neon Museum hosts some of Las Vegas' iconic vintage neon signs, including the original Stardust sign as well as many others. The museum is dedicated to collecting, preserving, studying and exhibiting Las Vegas neon signs for educational, historic, arts and cultural enrichment. The campus includes the outdoor exhibition space known as the Neon Boneyard, a visitors' center housed inside the former La Concha Motel lobby and the Neon Boneyard North Gallery which houses additional rescued signs. In 2018, The Neon Museum debuted "Brilliant!" which is a nighttime, audiovisual immersion experience that uses technology advances to reanimate 40 monumental examples of the museum's iconic vintage signs.

For the best view of the fountains and a panoramic view of the Las Vegas Valley, take an elevator ride to the observation deck atop the 46-story replica of the **Eiffel Tower** at **Paris Las Vegas**. In Feb. 2019, Paris Las Vegas debuted a \$1.7 million recurring light show inspired by the illuminations of the Eiffel Tower in France, featuring synchronized and choreographed twinkling and colored lights for visitors to enjoy nightly for free on The Strip.

Experience the scenery and natural beauty of the surrounding desert from the comfort of a vehicle. **Pink Jeep Tours** breaks off the beaten path to bring you to local iconic stops such as the Grand Canyon, Hoover Dam, Red Rock Canyon and Death Valley.

Nature-lovers can explore the great outdoors and experience the beauty of **Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area** with 19 hiking trails, a scenic driving loop, picnic areas and wildlife.

The need for speed is met at **Richard Petty Driving Experience** at the **Las Vegas Motor Speedway**. The adventurous can select from several NASCAR racing cars and fly around the track with 600 horses under the engine.

The **Rio All-Suite Hotel & Casino's VooDoo ZipLine** is a one-minute and 10-second zip ride that takes off from VooDoo Lounge, located atop Rio's 50-story Masquerade tower, sending guests cascading more than 800 feet to the Ipanema tower and reaching speeds up to 33 miles per hour. VooDoo Zipline can accommodate up to two riders at one time and has a unique feature – on the return trip guests will ride an additional 800 feet to the starting point facing backwards, a total ride of nearly one-third of a mile.

Swiss artist Ugo Rondinone's colorful, public artwork, **Seven Magic Mountains**, is an exhibition located in the desert outside of Las Vegas. The installment features seven towering dayglow totems comprised of painted, locally sourced boulders. Each "mountain" is over 30 feet high to exhibit the presence of color and expression in the desert of the Ivanpah Valley.

Sky Combat Ace (SCA) is the world's most extreme aviation attraction. Get behind the controls as YOU fly the plane under the supervision of a highly trained SCA fighter pilot. No experience required.

SPEEDVEGAS is a 100-acre motorsports complex that enables guests to experience the world's most sought-after muscle cars and exotic supercars, from Porsche, Ferrari, Lamborghini, Audi, Corvette and more. The experience features an impressive 1.5-mile (2.4 km) Formula One-inspired racetrack complete with 12 sweeping turns, 15-degree banked turns, 60 feet of total elevation change and a half-mile straightaway. In addition, the 20,000-square-feet, two-story welcome center features indoor and outdoor observation decks, meetings and event space and much more.

Springs Preserve features 180-acres of botanical gardens, walking trails, wildlife habitats, museums and more. The botanical gardens are home to the largest collection of Mojave Desert cacti and plants, a variety of wetland bird species, seasonal butterfly pavilion and other annual events. The educational institution's mission is to create a visitor experience that builds culture and community, inspires environmental stewardship and celebrates the vibrant history of the Las Vegas Valley.

The STRAT Hotel, Casino and Skypod has four of the world's highest rides, located 100 stories above the ground. SkyJump is a controlled free-fall in which participants plummet 855 feet at a speed of up to 40 miles per hour. X-Scream teeters riders over the edge of the tower 866 feet above the ground, 27 feet over the edge of the building, at 33 miles per hour. Big Shot is a thrill ride that shoots adrenaline-seekers 160 feet into the air at 45 miles per hour. With breathtaking views of the Las Vegas Valley, this 921-foot-high platform will be sure to elevate your senses. Insanity, appropriately named, at a height over 900 feet, spins passengers in the open air at speeds of up to three 'G's.

Tattoo'd America, the first interactive experience at Pop Vegas is open. Tattoo'd America celebrates the artistic, provocative and expressive qualities—as well as the sex appeal—of tattoo and body art. The attraction's immersive experiences, which are designed to delight both tattooed and non-tattooed guests, encompass 21 interactive installations and exhibits.

Topgolf Las Vegas is a four-level entertainment venue with interactive golf games and balls that score themselves. With climate-controlled hitting bays, hundreds of HDTVs, a stage for live concerts, water features with cabanas and event spaces, Topgolf caters to any crowd. And best of all, Topgolf is positioned perfectly to offer jaw-dropping views of the Las Vegas skyline while playing, eating, drinking and dancing the night away.

Experience a refreshing oasis of natural beauty just 40 minutes outside of the city with **Vegas Glass Kayaks**, Vegas' first and only crystal kayak tour. The clear kayaks and sparkling emerald water below The Hoover Dam create a tranquil view of the surrounding natural areas.

If you can't make it to Italy for a romantic gondola ride in Venice, the **gondola rides** at **The Venetian Resort Las Vegas** are the next best thing. Couples float through the vibrant Venetian

streetscape of the Grand Canal Shoppes in an authentic Venetian gondola as a talented singing gondolier sets the mood for romance, crooning romantic Italian songs like "That's Amore!" Private two-person gondolas are available, or couples can make it a double date and book a four-person gondola. A professional photographer will also be on hand to snap a few quick photos before the voyage, although couples are encouraged to bring their own cameras along as well. If the weather's nice, outdoor gondola rides are available, offering guests incredible views of the resort's striking architecture and the Las Vegas Strip.

The Venetian Resort Las Vegas is also home to the first karaoke lounge on the Strip. **KAMU** – **Ultra Karaoke** at the **Grand Canal Shoppes** offers more than 40 private karaoke rooms perfect for celebrations of all kinds. Whether guests are looking for a late-night hotspot with bachelorettes or a family-friendly afternoon with the kids, KAMU offers an up-tempo and upscale karaoke experience at all hours. KAMU features a kitchen with hand-crafted bites including fresh oysters, creative pizzas and even churro donut holes; as well as a full-service bar complete with an inspired cocktail program and bottle service ready to serve up liquid courage to guests in need.

Meet and greet some of the most famous celebrities in the world at **Madame Tussauds Wax Museum**. Located at **Grand Canal Shoppes** at **The Venetian Resort Las Vegas**, the museum showcases more than 100 wax figures of some of the world's most popular film, television, music and sports celebrities. Visitors can even interact with several "celebrity" experiences for a truly memorable photo opportunity.

The first Nevada location of **Museum of Dream Space** (MODS) can be found inside the **Grand Canal Shoppes** at **The Venetian Resort Las Vegas**. The multi-media art gallery utilizes state-of-the-art visual technology and stunning sculptures to provide an out of this world interactive experience that is photogenic and Instagram-approved.

Wynn Las Vegas invites golfers to play a round at the **Wynn Golf Club**. The 18-hole championship course was redesigned in late 2019, as famed golf course architect Tom Fazio returned to the property to give his original 2005 design a refresh. From lush greens to rushing streams, the course now features a dramatically reimagined topography from the opening drive to the final putt.

Looking for an off-road thrill? The **Zero1 Off-Road** and explore the Mojave Desert from behind the wheel of a Polaris RZR. Ride through scenic terrain, over ridges and into valleys on a guided tour. Zero1's purpose-built, safari-style performance touring cars take people away from the everyday, and to a place that can feel exhilarating, and fresh.
