Boasting spectacular shopping experiences with numerous flagship stores of sought-after luxury brands like Fendi, Tom Ford, Givenchy and Mulberry, Las Vegas has made its mark as a leader in the luxury retail world. From The Shops at Crystals and The Forum Shops at Caesars Palace to The Grand Canal Shoppes at The Venetian and The Miracle Mile Shops at Planet Hollywood Resort & Casino, the options are endless.

## **COMING SOON**

Fontainebleau Development has revealed the first details for the new luxury retail experience to debut within **Fontainebleau Las Vegas**, slated to open in winter 2023. Fontainebleau Development plans to create a shopping district that will span 90,000 square feet and feature approximately 35 luxury retail concepts across two levels. The shopping district will neighbor, either adjacent or above, Fontainebleau's 173,000-square-foot casino, dining experiences, and other offerings.

#### WHAT'S NEW

The Miracle Mile Shops at Planet Hollywood Resort & Casino has begun an extensive interior and exterior transformation. The renovation includes implementing elevated finishes, upgraded technology and digital design elements, as well as new entertainment features such as exterior and interior immersive light, sound, and video experiences. The premier mixed-use project, located at the heart of the famed Las Vegas Strip, will remain open during construction, which is set to be completed in spring of 2023.

The Strip's newest integrated resort, **Resorts World Las Vegas** offers a full lineup of retail venues. This includes the partnership with iconic Los Angeles-based experiential retailer, Fred Segal, with two mini flagship locations, one men's, one women's. The dynamic retail destination also features Judith Leiber evening bags and crystal minaudières; Hervé Léger women's apparel; Pepper, the first-ever, luxury intimate wellness store on the Las Vegas Strip; Twila True Fine Jewelry and Watches; Sneaker Garden premium sneaker boutique; Sugarfina luxury candy boutique; Nectar Bath Treats; Corso artisan jewelry; O bag customizable Italian handbags; Black Clover lifestyle apparel; and many more.

#### **SHOPPING ON THE STRIP**

Visitors can experience all the sights, sounds and smells of a traditional Middle Eastern market with the addition of the **Grand Bazaar Shops** outside of **Horseshoe Las Vegas**. Modeled after the famed Grand Bazaar in Istanbul, this two-acre outdoor walking mall is home to the first Wahlburgers Las Vegas location, as well as the only Giordano's pizzeria on the Strip, and more. Shoppers stroll under the brightly tiled roof as they visit

unique boutique retail spaces and experience a nightly light show featuring a 4,000-pound crystal in front of the store.

**Bellagio Resort & Casino** is recognized as one of the most opulent, high-end resorts in the world. In keeping with Bellagio's luxurious setting, **Via Bellagio** offers exquisite fashion and jewelry collections from Guerlain, Hermès, Prada, Chanel, Tiffany & Co., Harry Winston, Dior and Fendi.

The Forum Shops at Caesars Palace is recognized worldwide as offering the premier combination of luxury retail, excellent location, entertainment and thematic ambient surroundings with more than 160 specialty shops and restaurants. According to ICSC, The Forum Shops at Caesars Palace remains among the top-performing retail centers in Las Vegas based on sales per square-foot and is among the top enclosed centers nationwide. Boutiques exclusive to Las Vegas at The Forum Shops include Blancpain and CH Carolina Herrera. Other popular shops include Brooks Brothers, Chloé, Georgio Armani, and John Varvatos, among many more.

**The Cosmopolitan of Las Vegas** has assembled an eclectic collection of shops on the third floor of the resort. From limited-edition sneakers at CRSVR Sneaker Boutique to unique stores including ALLSAINTS and Molly Brown's Swimwear, to bespoke custom suiting at Stitched, this retail destination features something for every shopper.

Fashion Show Las Vegas is nearly 2 million square feet and expanding, making it the largest shopping mall on the Las Vegas Strip. Fashion Show offers an exceptional lineup of anchor stores with Neiman Marcus, Saks Fifth Avenue and Nordstrom, and more than 250 shops and boutiques. Dine at El Segundo Sol, Maggiano's Little Italy, RA Sushi, The Capital Grille, California Pizza Kitchen, Johnny Rockets, NM Café and more. In keeping with its name, Fashion Show includes an elevated runway for staging events such as fashion shows and special promotions. The Strip-side front features "The Cloud," a 128-foot multimedia platform, as well as an all-new 3D nature-inspired staircase mural installation on the northern Plaza stairs by local artist Michael Dodson.

The LINQ Promenade at The LINQ Hotel + Experience is an open-air retail, dining and entertainment district, anchored by the world's tallest observation wheel, The High Roller. It features more than 30 unique shops, restaurants and entertainment venues and plays host to a variety of special events, festivals and more. Shoppers can visit Pier 30, Goorin Brothers Hat Shop, Havaianas, Honolulu Cookie Company, Chili Beans and more.

The Shoppes at Mandalay Place is 100,000 square feet of retail space and connects Mandalay Bay Resort & Casino with Luxor Hotel & Casino via a 310-foot-long retail sky bridge. Retailers and restaurants include LUSH Fresh Handmade Cosmetics, Ron Jon Surf Shop and Pandora, while dining options include Hubert Keller's Burger Bar, Rí Rá Irish Pub and Hussong's Mexican Cantina.

**Miracle Mile Shops** at **Planet Hollywood Resort & Casino** is the 1.2-mile retail/entertainment complex at the heart of Las Vegas Boulevard. Miracle Mile features nearly 170 specialty stores, as well as restaurants bars, and live entertainment. Shops and boutiques include Urban Outfitters, Iululemon, Quiksilver, Sephora and Victoria's Secret. Dining options include Buffalo Wild Wings; Hot N Juicy Crawfish and Nacho

Daddy.

The 500,000-square-foot retail and dining district, **The Shops at Crystals**, located adjacent to ARIA Resort & Casino, is one of Las Vegas' premier shopping experiences. The Shops at Crystals showcases an unprecedented array of the world's most exclusive retailers, including many flagship stores. For many of these brands, the Crystals' location represents their largest in Las Vegas, the United States or, in some cases, the world. Luxury retailers include Christian Louboutin, Louis Vuitton, Gucci, Ermenegildo Zegna, Tiffany & Co., Prada, Dior, Bylgari, Hermès, Balenciaga, Cartier, Van Cleef & Arpels, Versace and more. Crystals is the only Las Vegas location where you will find boutiques by Tom Ford, Yves Saint Laurent and Richard Mille.

Cobblestone walkways line **The Grand Canal Shoppes** and its 500,000 square feet of unique retail space within **The Venetian Las Vegas**. This indoor shopping area features an authentic reproduction of Venice's Grand Canal, complete with gondolas and a replica of St. Mark's Square, which serves as the centerpiece of the mall area. Among the more than 80 shops, restaurants and attractions are Burberry, Jimmy Choo, Kate Spade and Steve Madden, as well as restaurants, including Buddy V's Ristorante, Delmonico Steakhouse and Grand Lux Café.

When Wynn Las Vegas opened, it brought one of the more high-end shopping experiences to the Las Vegas Strip. **Wynn Esplanade** at **Wynn Las Vegas** features the first Givenchy boutique designer store in the country. Among the big-name shops in the Wynn Esplanade are Alexander McQueen, Cartier, Louis Vuitton and Christian Dior.

Bordering the glittering curves and the rotund bronze sculptures of the entrance to XS Nightlclub, the **Encore Esplanade** at **Wynn Las Vegas** offers luxury shopping with sunlit corridors and a view of the shimmering Encore resort pool. Select stores include Amiri, Brunello Cucinelli and Christian Louboutin.

**Wynn Plaza**, a 70,000-square-foot retail destination located directly on Las Vegas Boulevard at **Wynn Las Vegas** offers a new world of renowned luxury in the destination. Brands that can only be found in Las Vegas at Wynn Plaza include Céline and Balmain. Additional boutiques include Kiton, Omega, RIMOWA, Breitling, Le Lab, Bottega Veneta, Saint Laurent, and the only permanent Louis Vuitton Men's store in the country.

# **OUTLET MALLS**

Visitors just entering Nevada can shop right at the state line in Primm at the **Prizm Outlets.** The outlets offer unbelievable savings on top-of-the-line and designer merchandise at retailers such as Levi's Outlet Store, Michael Kors, Bath & Body Works and more.

Las Vegas North Premium Outlets has over 180 designer and name brand outlet stores and restaurants. Saks Fifth Avenue Off 5th and Las Vegas' first Pandora outlet add to the attractive and impressive list of stores that includes Armani Exchange, Tory Burch, Burberry, Coach, Dolce & Gabbana, Marc Jacobs, Polo Ralph Lauren, Scotch & Soda, St. John, Theory and many more.

The 140 stores and eateries at Las Vegas South Premium Outlets include Guess,

True Religion, Under Armour, Michael Kors, LOFT Outlet, Calvin Klein, Nautica, Nike, Reebok, Levi's, Adidas and Gap. This indoor mall, complete with two food courts and a carousel, is located on the southern end of the Strip. The center is a short cab ride from the Strip and is served by a Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) bus.

#### **OFF-STRIP SHOPPING**

If you want to shop like the locals, you can find plenty of shopping excitement off the Strip, too. **The Boulevard Mall** features 1 million square feet of retail space, with shops such as Journeys, Old Navy and Zumiez. Completed in 2015, the Boulevard Mall underwent a multimillion-dollar renovation, including new tenants, a farmers' market, valet parking, free Wi-Fi, and upgrades to the food court and exterior façade.

The District at Green Valley Ranch is one of the more unique shopping experiences in Las Vegas with more than 70 shops and restaurants situated along a tree-lined street adjacent to Green Valley Ranch Resort, Casino & Spa. The anchors at The District include Williams-Sonoma, Pottery Barn and Chico's, with other stores being firsts to Las Vegas, such as REI and Anthropologie. The District features cobblestone sidewalks, park benches and pet-friendly areas. Restaurants include King's Fish House, P.F. Chang's, Settebello Pizzeria Napoletana and SkinnyFATS.

Located on historic **Freemont Street**, the open-air **Downtown Container Park** offers a variety of boutique shopping, dining and entertainment destinations, all housed in shipping containers creatively combined and stacked for sustainability. The iconic animated praying mantis welcomes all to the Park with music and coordinated flames shooting from antennae. Retail destinations within include Art Box, Lovo Cigars, Sassy the Boutique and Sugar Shop Candy & Gifts. The Park also features food and beverage options with outdoor space to enjoy such as Oak & Ivy, Downtown Terrace and Bin 702.

**Downtown Summerlin** off Sahara and the 215 freeway is a one-stop destination for all shopping needs. The outdoor shopping mecca features over 100 retailers and restaurants, a movie theater and spa. Shoppers can stroll through lush landscaping and water accents while shopping at department stores Dillard's, Macy's and favorites such as Express, Nordstrom Rack, Sephora, LUSH Fresh Handmade Cosmetics and Sur La Table. Eateries include Grape Street Café & Wine Bar to Shake Shack and Wolfgang Puck Players Locker.

**Galleria at Sunset** is located at Sunset Road and Stephanie Street in Henderson, Nev., about 12 miles east of Las Vegas. The Galleria recently completed a 30,000 square-foot expansion project, adding dining options and renovating several of the interior common areas. The updates accompany the extensive list of stores such as JCPenney, Macy's, Kohl's, Buckle, Champs Sports and many more.

**The Meadows Mall** exemplifies the ease of one-stop, convenient shopping in a multilevel center located near the U.S. 95 Expressway at Valley View Blvd. The mall has two levels of specialty stores and five courtyards, with anchor stores including Dillard's, JCPenney and Macy's Backstage.

Tivoli Village offers unique stores and boutiques such as The Shade Store, Restoration

Hardware, Matriarch and more, along with diverse restaurants including Ada's, Echo & Rig, Al Solito Posto and more.

**Town Square Las Vegas** is a shopping, dining and entertainment center on Las Vegas Boulevard, located minutes from Harry Reid International Airport (LAS). The open-air center features an eclectic collection of shops, including favorites Bath & Body Works, Express, Hollister Co., Sephora, and many more. Twenty-two buildings detail a collage of architectural styles, while pedestrian-friendly streets and walkways provide the ideal atmosphere for enjoying a day with the family. Town Square also includes an 18-screen movie theater; an interactive children's park; and dining experiences such as Double Helix Wine & Whiskey Lounge, McFadden's and Blue Martini.
